Moosa AL-Moosa is the Dow Country President for the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and Dow Shareholder Representative for the Sadara Joint Venture.

In his role as Country President for Saudi Arabia, AL-Moosa leads the organization to execute Dow's growth strategy in the Kingdom. In addition to his geography role, AL-Moosa is also responsible for managing all Dow shareholder related matters with the Sadara joint venture. He is the lead for the Dow Sadara Program Office that oversees activities related to the execution of contracts between Dow and Sadara and leads Dow activities on the Sadara Marketing Council.

In his previous role, AL-Moosa, was the General Manager for Dow United Arab Emirates and the Finance Director for India, Middle East, Africa and Turkey.

AL-Moosa joined Dow's Finance function in 2005 in Midland, where he completed a number of assignments across several departments including financial and statutory accounting, cost accounting, tax, auditing, business finance and treasury. Two years later, he moved to Mergers and Acquisitions and was responsible for leading transaction teams on acquisitions, divestitures and joint venture projects. In 2009, AL-Moosa was named Finance Director for the Ras Tanura Integrated Project (now known as Sadara) before being appointed as Finance Director for Middle East and Africa in 2010. In 2011, he assumed additional responsibilities as General Manager for Dow United Arab Emirates. In 2015 his finance role was expanded to include India and Turkey, and he was named Finance Director for the India, Middle East, Africa and Turkey region.

Prior to joining Dow, AL-Moosa worked with several financial institutions such as Citigroup Asset Management in Stamford, Connecticut; J.P. Morgan Chase in New York and London, and Deutsche Bank's New York office.

AL-Moosa holds a Masters of Business Administration from the Wharton School of Business at the University of Pennsylvania and a Bachelor of Arts in Economics from Georgetown University in Washington D.C.
